

These sound loaded scenes are great for working on articulation carryover in connected speech. Use the suggested prompts to elicit target words in sentences, stories, or conversation.



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Do you have students working on using comparative and superlative forms of adjectives? This resource is just what you need!

This packet contains adjective stimulus items that can be used to practice comparative and superlative forms. Each page has 2 or 3 pictures with a prompt at the top.



This is an interactive NO PRINT resource for irregular plural nouns. Students tap the screen to select their answer as they practice irregular plural nouns.

This file can be opened on a computer, tablet, or interactive smart board. Use a pdf viewer to open. Students can tap the screen to navigate through the file. Includes 20 target irregular plural nouns.



Each page presents a real photo for the target word, with visual symbols for the adjective. Students are able to select the adjective that best goes with the picture and complete the sentence to practice using the target word.



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


Use this digital visual schedule during your teletherapy sessions. This visual schedule is completely digital and editable.
